Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who can be a Volunteer?

A: Anyone wanting to volunteer their time to give back to the community by using current skills and gaining new ones.

Q: How does one apply for volunteer opportunities?

A: All interested applicants can view a list of opportunities and sign up by clicking the "join Cathedral City" button at the bottom of the page.

Q: What do Volunteers do?

A: City of Cathedral City volunteers assist City staff by providing support that enhances the work of City employees. Some of the help volunteers provide includes; clerical assignments like filing, sorting, data entry, mass mailing assistance and other tasks; reception area duties like answering phones, taking messages and some public assistance; and other opportunities depending on the needs of the department.

Q: How much time will I need to commit if I want to volunteer?

A: Each volunteer opportunity will request a minimum time commitment. Volunteer opportunities can be a few hours per day or a weekly commitment for the span of a season or year. Whatever your availability, there may be an opportunity that fits your schedule and meets your needs.

Q: What is the difference between an Intern and a Volunteer?

A: An Intern is required to be enrolled in school during the Internship while the volunteer opportunity is simply to serve and to engage in the community.
